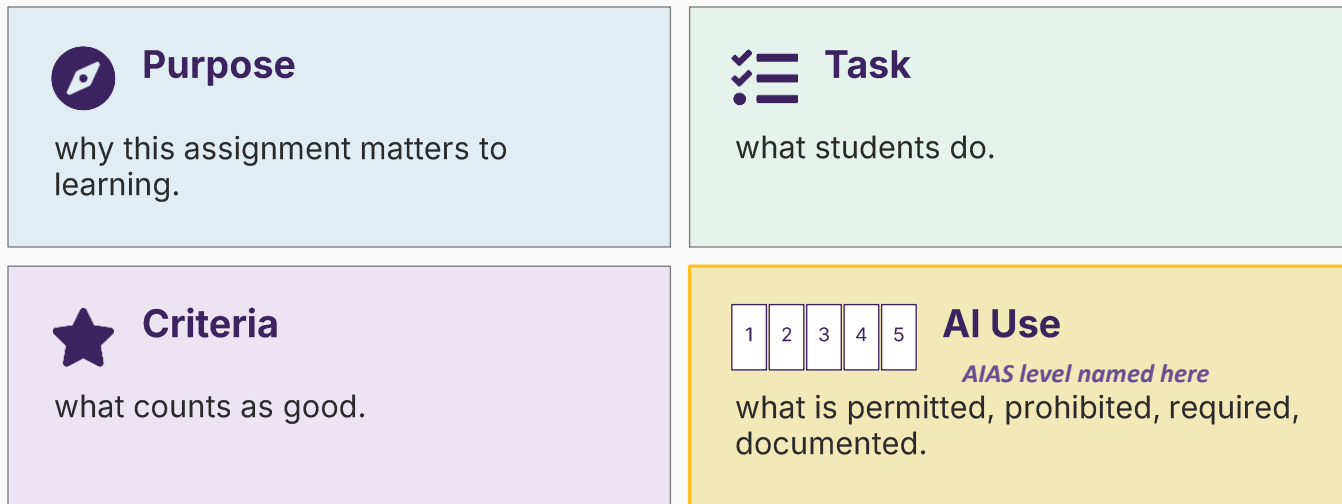

Transparent and Authentic Assessment in the AI Era

The Transparent Contract: TILT, with AI added.



We add the AI Use box because students cannot infer your AIAS choice. Make it visible.

Authentic ≠ 'real world.'

Real world decoration

"Imagine you are a Fortune 500 CEO ..."

≠

Authentic discipline mapping

"Write a brief for a county health director deciding whether to fund X based on the data we have studied."

Authentic means the audience, genre, and constraint match a situation a student might actually encounter, anchored in unique course data.

Before.

opaque

Write a 900-word evidence brief on the case we studied this week. Use course concepts and outside evidence to make your argument. You may use AI if it helps, but your work should be your own. Submit a final draft and be ready to discuss it. Your grade will be based on quality, clarity, and evidence. Upload the assignment by Sunday.

- *What is the purpose?*
- *What are the criteria?*
- *Where can AI be used?*

Students cannot tell what matters, what counts, or where AI fits.

transparent

Purpose

Practice using course concepts to make a decision for a named audience, not simply summarize the case.

Task

Write a 900-word evidence brief recommending one option from the case packet to a program director.

Criteria

Strong work explains the decision, uses two course concepts accurately, cites case evidence, and names one tradeoff.

AI Use

AI may be used for planning questions only. Do not use it to draft the recommendation. Note any planning use in one sentence.

What does not change.
